CHECKLIST

- _____ **Vacuum all floors and furniture thoroughly. (VERY IMPORTANT)!**
- _____ Remove all pets such as dogs, cats, hamsters, birds, etc.
- _____ Place all pet food, water, and pet toys to a non-accessible area.
- _____ Remove any potpourri, deodorizers, air freshners at least 2 hours prior to the inspection.
- _____ Close all windows and outside doors. There must not be any air drafts at least 2 hours prior to inspection.
- _____ Have each room as clutter free as possible. **The canine team must have access to all furniture.** This ensures the highest detailed inspection possible.
- _____ There must not be any noise or human distractions. Our dog and handler are very focused to provide you the best inspection possible.
- _____ Turn off all oscillating/box fans, exhaust fans, and ceiling fans at least 30 minutes prior to arrival.
- _____ **Extinguish all smoking materials 2 hours prior to the inspection. This is very important!**
- _____ No pesticides applications can be used at least 30 days prior to inspection. If an application has been done then please let us know.
- _____ If there are any spilled syringes, pills, or any other medication in the search area, the canine team may refuse the inspection until the items have been removed.

Our Canine Scent Detection Specialist will perform at the highest possible accuracy but we need all of the conditions met. If the above checklist is not followed we will may refuse to do the inspection. This is very important for our dog's safety.
