KEY RISKS TO YOUR BUSINESS



Rodents – Contaminate food and surfaces and destroy equipment, wiring, and physical structures. May carry disease-causing pathogens.



Flies – Contaminate food and surfaces, potentially spreading Salmonella and other types of bacteria that can make people sick.



Cockroaches – Contaminate food and surfaces. May carry pathogens that can cause disease, such as E. coli and Salmonella.



Bed bugs – One bed bug encounter can seriously impact a brand's reputation, resulting in potential claims and financial loss.



Ants – Contaminate food and surfaces. Bites may cause allergic reactions. Known to infest equipment and chew wires, potentially causing electrical disruptions.



Birds – Droppings can be a slip and fall hazard and may contain harmful bacteria. Nesting materials and feathers can damage equipment and pose a potential fire risk.



Stored product pests – Destroy and contaminate products and goods. Known for carrying bacteria that may cause food-borne illnesses. Can cause significant financial loss.
